A small class with no more than 10-15 students provides more chances to learn and to engage.

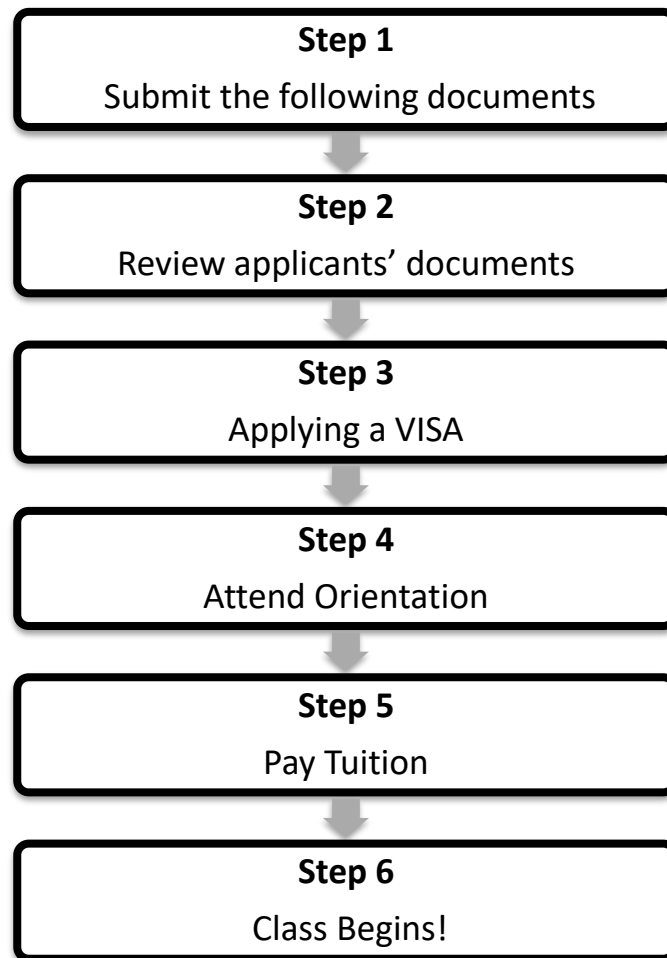
#### IV. One-hour Tutoring time

### 3. HOW DO I APPLY PRACTICAL CHINESE CLASS?



#### **Step 1: Submit the following documents.**

##### I. Registration document:

- Application form
- Diploma /Certificate of Enrolment /Report card
- Health examination report with HIV Test Result
- A copy of passport
- 3 1-inch photos
- Accident insurance and medical insurance certificate (If you do not have insurance, The center of Mandarin Learning will apply for you, 3 months NT\$1,000)
- Financial resource proof (At least NT\$80,000)

## **Step 2: Review applicants' documents.**

All of the documents are reviewed by the Center of Mandarin Learning, and if admitted, students will be conformed both by e-mail and a mailing letter.

## **Step 3: Applying VISA**

To obtain a visa, a student from abroad and for those who have received an admission letter should go with that letter to the R.O.C. Embassy, Consulate, or Representative Agency in their area for the application of a sixty-day visitor's visa at first. Visitor visas are initially valid for only those sixty days. However, upon students' arrival in Taiwan, they may apply for the further two sixty-day extensions. After studying for four consecutive months, students may apply for a resident visa.

### VISA

Please obtain your passport and visa from abroad. Those who received a MCL admission letter should apply for an extendable visitor visa with that letter at any ROC Embassy, Consulate, or Representative Agency in your own country or overseas residence.

For Mandarin students, either an extendable visitor visa or student visa may be applied for. Visitor visa can be extended twice, each time from 60 to 90 days for up to 6 months. Only students who study for 4 consecutive months apply for or transfer to a student visa.

## **Step 4: Attend Orientation**

Orientation is held a week before each term starts.

## **Step 5: Pay tuition**

The process of registration for comers requires approximately one week and begins a week before each term starts. All registrations must be completed in person.

Please follow the instruction to register:

- I. Registration: admission letter, passport, visa, two passport photos, a completed and registration form are all needed to be presented.
- II. Tuition payment: tuitions and fees must be paid in New Taiwan dollars at the Center of Mandarin Learning. The full amount of the fee must be paid before the term begins.
- III. Class Selection: a placement test is held during the registration week, and students will be placed to the appropriate level base on the results of the test.
